



**TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS**

Distance from Prescott to TH is 6 miles, all blacktop. From Courthouse Plaza, drive east out of Prescott on Gurley St and SR 69 to Walker Rd, at the traffic light by Costco. Drive south on Walker Rd 1.8 miles to the Highlands Center for Natural History. Follow the concrete path to the trailhead next to the amphitheater.

Description: This site was once home to “Prescott Culture” people who fished and farmed along Lynx Creek from about 1150 to 1300 AD. These ruins were once a multi-room structure and home to 20-25 people.

The 2.5 mile short hike (red trail) is out and back to the ruins using trails #443, #305, and #301.

For a longer hike of 3.5 miles, (light blue), add #444, #442, #445, and #305.

For a 5.6 mile hike (dark blue), add the Lynx Lake Shore Trail.

Follow the road to the Gold Pan TH

Take the broad trail by the boat rental to #305
