


### TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS

From the Plaza, drive to the west out of Prescott on Gurley Street for 1.8 miles to reach Sherwood Drive (first left after Hassayampa Village Lane).  
 - On the way, Gurley St has become Thumb Butte Rd. On Sherwood Drive, at just under 0.2 miles, look on your left for a large wooden sign:  
 "Stricklin Park, Butte Creek Trail"  
 Continue past sign to Autumn Drive and do a U-turn. Park on the right on Sherwood, anywhere before sign.  
 - Gravel trail starts between upright rocks by the sign.  
 - Do NOT take the concrete path nearer Autumn Drive.  
 On the trail, keep right at the next two junctions:  
 - First: just over the bridge/dam. Second: at top of rise.  
**Total out-and-back hike is 2.8 miles (moderate)**  
 TH elevation is 5500 feet, turn around is 5850 feet
