

TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS

Drive northwest out of Prescott on Iron Springs Road (YC 10) to the trail head at milepost 4.4.
 - Trail head is 4.4 miles from Willow Creek Rd (hospital intersection) or 3 miles past Williamson Valley Road.
 - Turn left onto a dirt road across a cattle guard.
 - This turn is easy to miss; it's at the end of a guard rail.
 - Park along either side of dirt road (don't block gate).
 Take the trail to the north, which is across Iron Springs Rd.
- Traffic can move fast, so be very careful when crossing.
Total out-and-back hike is 4.0 miles (moderate)
 Elevation (both ends) ~5950 feet. Low point (creek) 5740'
