


WILDERNESS INFORMATION Here is a quote from the 1964 Wilderness act: "Wilderness is an area of undeveloped Federal land retaining its primeval character and influence, without permanent improvement or human habitation."

TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS

Drive NW out of Prescott on Iron Springs Road and turn right (north) onto Williamson Valley Rd (YC 5). At 6.5 miles from Iron Springs Road, turn left into Williamson Valley Trail Head parking (at MP 6.5).
 - This is just before the fire station on the left.
 - Park at north end, not where horse trailers park.
 Hike south along western perimeter of parking area to reach start of trail #308 (and also trail #347).
 - Signs mark this start point. Go west on trail #308.
Total out-and-back hike is 6.2 miles (strenuous).
 Elevation (both ends) 5200 feet, undulating between!
