



TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS
Distance: Prescott to TH is 5 miles, all blacktop.
 Drive east on Gurley Street from Courthouse Square to jct of US 89 and AZ 69. Go left (north) on US 89, and go 3.5 miles to roundabout.
 - Go right at roundabout into Watson Lake Park and pay \$2 fee at kiosk (free on Wednesdays).
 - Turn right on road just after kiosk and drive to end at lake. Park near the boat pier.
 - Trail starts at edge of tarmac (sign), just north of pier.
Total loop hike is 5.0 miles (strenuous).
Use maps on signposts to help take right trail.
 - TH elevation is 5200 feet. The loop stays close to this elevation the whole way, but is NOT flat!
 This is a world-class scenic trail – don't miss it!!
 - Until you reach the Peavine, this trail goes through the Granite Dells. It has many climbs and drops, some steep, so be prepared for this.
 - Follow white dots where trail crosses native granite.
 - There is essentially no shade on the whole loop.
