

TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS

Distance: Prescott to TH is 2.3 miles, including 0.4 miles dirt. Drive E on Gurley Street from Courthouse Square to junction of US 89 and AZ 69. Go right onto Robinson (between Enterprise and Prescottonian). Then go left onto Hillcrest which becomes Butterfield. Continue on Butterfield, winding up all the way to Wells Fargo at a 5-way junction. Bend slightly right onto this dirt road. Where this road goes sharp left, instead go right (by a sign for the Turley Trail). Go on this bumpy track, through an unlocked gate, to a small parking area at the trailhead.

- The TH is 1.0 miles from AZ 69, and is a challenging route to find.

You can choose from two options for how far you hike:

1: total to early turn-around is 2.2 miles (easy to moderate)

2: distance one way is 4.9 miles (strenuous). You'll need 2 cars


TH elevation is 5690', high point is 6050' (after early turn-around)

Description: This new part of the Circle Trail is very hilly, with many ups and downs, so be prepared. Go on a cloudy day or later in the year -- there is no shade. There are many grand views looking down on the city and the mountains beyond.

Option 2 directions: Towards the end, go right off the Sundog Trail at its junction with the Old Bullwhacker Hill Road up to York Motors.

At York Motors, walk round the south of the building and continue to the traffic light at the entrance (they are friendly to hikers).

Cross Prescott Lakes Pkwy to where you parked your second car. This last segment from the Sundog Trail is 0.3 miles.



PRESCOTT CIRCLE TRAIL
The Badger Mtn Trail is part of the Prescott Circle Trail. The Circle Trail is a little over 50 miles long and goes all around the City of Prescott. It was completed in June 2015 (all but a two mile segment). For more info, purchase a copy of the *Guide to the Circle Trail* from the Highlands Center or from the Prescott Chamber of Commerce downtown.
