




DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO TRAIL HEAD
Distance, Prescott to TH, is 46 miles incl 22 miles dirt.
 This is a long way, but the drive is delightful and interesting!
 Drive NW out of Prescott on Williamson Valley Road (YC 5) to Walnut Creek Rd (YC 125), 36 miles from Iron Springs Rd.
 - First 22 miles of Williamson Valley Road is blacktop, then a good dirt surface.
 - Junction with YC 125 is 0.3 miles past iron bridge over Walnut Creek.
 Turn left (west) on Walnut Creek Road (good dirt) and drive 8.4 miles on YC 125 to trail head on right (well signed).
 - The trail starts at the north end of the parking area, shortly before a trail register.
Total out-and-back hike is 3.4 miles (moderate)
 TH elevation is 5950 feet, Spring is at 6500 feet
 This trail is partly open and partly under the pines.
