


### TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS

**Distance: Prescott to TH is 10 miles blacktop, 0.2 dirt.**  
 Drive NW out of Prescott on Iron Springs Road (YC10) to junction with Skyline Drive (YC 120) at milepost 5.2 (Highland Pines sign).  
 - This jct is 5.2 miles from Willow Creek Rd (hospital intersection).  
 Turn left (south) at this jct onto Skyline Drive to Highland Pines.  
 Drive 3.0 miles on Skyline Drive to end of blacktop, then:  
 - Continue uphill on dirt road for 0.2 miles into the National Forest (boundary is past Starview Ln, just after the house on the right).  
 Park ASAP just off dirt road (or along the side where width allows).  
 - Go slowly up this rough road – best with high clearance vehicle.  
 - Option is to park at bottom of hill and walk up to forest boundary.  
 Do NOT attempt to drive on roads marked with a double asterisk.  
**Total loop hike is 3.2 miles (moderate)** Do loops clockwise.  
 TH elevation is 6560 feet, high point is 7060 feet  
**Description:** Trail winds through the pines, with good shade.  
 Part of this trail is single track and part is on little used forest roads (minimal signage) – unlikely to meet any vehicles. Some of the forest roads are steep, up and down – hiking poles could help.
