



TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS

Distance: Prescott to TH is 7.5 miles, all blacktop.
 Drive NW out of Prescott on Iron Springs Rd (YC10) to jct with Granite Basin Rd (FR 374) at milepost 3.0.
 - This junction is 3.0 miles from Willow Creek Road (hospital intersection) or 1.6 miles past Williamson Valley Road.
 Turn right (north) at junction onto Granite Basin Road.
 - Drive 3.1 miles to Wekuvde picnic area on right and park there. This is the same TH as Spree trails 7 and 8.
This is a Fee Area, so display your Spree brochure.
 Take trail 350 to northeast. Do loop clockwise.
 - Start of trail 350 is on right, about 50 yards in from GB Road (NOT near washrooms). It starts by first (leftmost) of 8 short wooden posts by carsonite sign.
 - Trail 350 immediately crosses a former road and heads towards a picnic table, then down to meet trail 351 after 0.1 mile (junction is across dry creek).
 - For return route, note point where 350 (sign) joins 351.
Total loop hike is 3.6 miles (moderate)
 TH elevation is 5620 feet, high point is 5870 feet.
Description: Trail winds up and down through pines and past large boulders, with views of Granite Mountain. Loop is also popular with mountain bikers.
