

IMPORTANT! Hike CLOCKWISE from parking!

TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS


Distance: Prescott to TH is 8.1 miles, including 0.6 miles dirt.
 From the Courthouse Square, drive 0.5 miles east on Gurley St to the traffic light at Mount Vernon. Turn right at the light onto Mount Vernon (which becomes the Senator Highway) and drive for 7.2 miles to a junction. This jct is after passing the Sky Y camp on your right, and shortly after the end of the blacktop. Turn right (south) at jct (sign says Pine Summit Camp). Continue for 0.4 miles to the junction with FR 707, which goes off to the right (NW). - Park at the junction where you won't block traffic.

To start the hike, cross road to trail 384, which drops down.

Total loop hike is 5.0 miles (moderate to strenuous)

TH elevation is 6180 feet, low point 5700 feet, high pt 6200 feet

Description: This winding trail through the pines is all motorized so possibility of dirt bikes, ATVs or even vehicles but chances are low. The trail is sometimes eroded so hiking poles may be good. This trail is by the Hassayampa River in one place and crosses Wolf Creek twice. There are lots of ups and downs along the way.
