



TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS
Distance: Prescott to TH is 6 miles, all blacktop.
 Drive to Walker Road on Highway 69 – this is east out of Prescott and west out of Prescott Valley.
 - Walker Road is at the traffic light by the ARCO gas station (just west of Costco), at milepost 293
 Turn south onto Walker Road (YC 57) and go 1.8 miles to the entrance to the Highland Center on the left (east) side of the road.
 Turn in and keep right to the parking area.
 - Follow the concrete path past the main building, and wind down to the amphitheater.
 - Continue onto the dirt trail, and go east on trail #443 to junction with trail #442.
 - Turn left (north) there and hike loop clockwise.
 - Mountain bikes use trail #305 too, so be aware!
Total loop hike is 0.8 miles (easy).

OPTION: LONGER HIKE
 Go east on trail #442 before completing the loop (Lynx Creek is 0.4 miles)

NOTE: gate is locked
 7PM to 7AM Apr-Sep
 6PM to 8AM Oct-Mar
