

### TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS

**Distance: Prescott to TH is 6.5 miles, all blacktop**

- Drive north out of Prescott on Willow Creek Road to junction with Commerce Drive (second light after Fry's, before Tim's).
  - This jct is 4.0 miles from Whipple Street (hospital intersection).
  - Turn left onto Commerce and go 0.9 miles to second STOP sign.
  - Turn left there into Kuebler Field (Brad Ziegler/APS/D'backs).
  - Go past open gate. Park on right ASAP, on gravel lot.
  - Walk back to gate to where trail starts on left, going north.
  - No signs here. Hike down this trail, to a culvert on right.
  - Trail is concrete here (Jan Alfano Trail goes east through culvert).
  - Continue north on the double track trail, which bends left uphill.
- Total loop hike is 2.5 miles (easy).** Hike loop counterclockwise. TH elevation is 5240 feet, high point is 5380 feet.


**Description:** The Legacy Trail is part of the Prescott Circle Trail. It is an enjoyable trail, seldom used. Once north of Pioneer Pkwy, it is mainly out of sight of civilization. This winding trail has many ups and downs, with good views from the ridges. There's no shade so go on a cloudy day, or later in season when cooler. The Legacy trail is single track, other Pioneer Park trails are double track.



**PRESCOTT CIRCLE TRAIL**  
This trail is about 50 miles long and goes all around the City of Prescott. It should be completed by the end of this year (2014), all but a two mile segment. Good views from ridge (Granite Dells, Glassford Hill, Granite Mountain)

**OPTION: LONGER HIKE:**  
Instead of going left and through Middle Underpass, turn right uphill along Circle Tr to West Underpass. Go though W Underpass and then NE, parallel to Pioneer Parkway, back to Spree Loop (extra 1 mile)



No sign here. Turn right at sharp angle onto single track (about 100 yards past green carsonite sign).
