


**TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS**

**Distance:** Prescott to TH is 7.5 miles, all blacktop.  
 Drive NW out of Prescott on Iron Springs Rd (YC10) to jct with Granite Basin Rd (FR 374) at milepost 3.0.  
 - This junction is 3.0 miles from Willow Creek Road (hospital intersection) or 1.6 miles past Williamson Valley Road.  
 Turn right (north) at junction onto Granite Basin Road.  
 - Drive 3.1 miles to Wekuvde picnic area on right and park there. This is the same TH as Spree trails 6 and 7.  
**This is a Fee Area, so display your Spree brochure.**  
 Take trail 350 to northeast.  
 - Start of trail 350 is on right, about 50 yards in from GB Road (NOT near washrooms). It starts by first (leftmost) of 8 short wooden posts by carsonite sign.  
 - Trail 350 immediately crosses a former road and heads towards a picnic table, then down to meet trail 351 after 0.1 mile (junction is across dry creek).  
 - For return route, note point where 350 (sign) joins 351.  
**Total out-and-back hike is 6.4 miles (strenuous)**  
 TH elevation is 5620 feet, low point is 5300 feet  
**Description:** This pretty trail stays close to Mint Wash, with pines and riparian trees along the way. There are ups and downs in places, fairly steep north of the lake.



OPTION: LONGER HIKE  
 Go northwest on trail 345 for as long as you like.

Turn-around pt.  
 Junction of trails 345 and 347 by metal gate

**Wilderness Information** Here is a quote from the 1964 Wilderness Act: "Wilderness is an area of undeveloped Federal land retaining its primeval character and influence, without permanent improvement or human habitation."

This trail looks different now. It was widened to act as a fire break during the Doce Fire so shade has been reduced. (Fire stopped high on mountain)

The Mint Wash Trail, #345, should reopen on October 1. It was closed after the Doce Fire. Check date with National Forest.

**GRANITE MOUNTAIN WILDERNESS**

For a shorter hike, park at Boat Launch. Spree brochure is NOT valid here, so pay fee unless you have a pass or it's Wednesday.
