



TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS

Distance: Prescott to TH is 3.5 miles, all blacktop.
 From the Plaza, drive west out of Prescott on Gurley St for 3.5 miles to the Thumb Butte parking area. On the way Gurley Street becomes Thumb Butte Road.
 - Parking entrance is on right, 100 yards past crosswalk (before Thumb Butte Road bends to the left).
 - Drive through the first part of the parking area, and go left across bridge. Park near the TH for trail #316 (opposite rest rooms). This is past TH for trail #315.
Fee area: display your Spree brochure.
 - brochure is only good on weekdays.
Total loop hike is 2.9 miles (easy to moderate).
 TH elevation 5725 feet, high point 6020 feet
Description: Hike loop counter clockwise.
 There are some good views from the higher points.
 The trail is undulating. Only parts of the trail are shaded.



PRESCOTT CIRCLE TRAIL
 Trails 332 and 392 are part of the Prescott Circle Trail. The Circle Trail is a little over 50 miles long and goes all around the City of Prescott. It was completed in mid-2015 (all but a two mile segment). For more info, purchase a copy of the *Guide to the Circle Trail* from the Highlands Center or from the Prescott Chamber of Commerce downtown.
