


DRIVING DIRECTIONS AND DESCRIPTION

Round trip distance from downtown Prescott (total drive, 9A and 9B) is 28.5 miles, including 10.0 miles dirt.

Almost half of this interesting drive is on dirt roads, which is OK for most vehicles if you take your time. However, an SUV or pick-up may be preferable. If you only have a small car, invite a friend with a higher clearance vehicle to drive – while you navigate!

- If you dislike dirt roads, after doing hike 9A return to Hwy 69 the way you came in (on Walker Rd, going north).
- If you are adventurous and curious, after driving back to Walker Road from the Charcoal Kiln, turn left (south).

The best time for autumn leaves is usually October, so do this drive then. The many interesting sights on the way are identified on this 9B map. Follow directions (with detailed descriptions) on the **two separate pages** to drive past all of these fascinating places, and the autumn leaves.
