

TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS

- Drive NW out of Prescott on Iron Springs Road (YC 10) to junction with Granite Basin Road (FR 374), at milepost 3.0.
- Junction is 3.0 miles from Willow Creek Road (hospital intersection) or 1.6 miles past Williamson Valley Road.
- Turn right (north) onto Granite Basin Road (FR 374)
- Drive 3.1 miles to the start of the one-way road loop.
- Turn right there and drive for 0.6 miles to Metate parking area (on left shortly after sharp bend). Park there.

This is a Fee Area (\$5). Free on Wednesdays.

To reach trail #40, follow the next five steps carefully:


- Trail #261 starts across road from parking area.
- Go for 0.2 miles as trail curves right then left to bottom and across wash. Ignore any trails to left or right before wash.
- At junction after wash, go left on trail #349 for 0.2 miles.
- At junction with trail #40, turn right (this is an old road).
- Trail #40 turns left off old road in 100 feet.

NOTE: Remember all these turns to retrace route on return!

Total out-and-back hike 4.9 miles (moderate-strenuous)

TH elevation is 5600 feet, end point (trl #37) is 6400 feet.

Description: This is a pretty hike, with some good views. The second half is mainly shaded along a wash with riparian trees. The last 1/2 mile winds and climbs steeply.
