

**TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS**

**Distance: Prescott to TH, is 25 miles, all blacktop.**  
 To reflect the upcoming AZ Centennial, this is one of four trails with historic interest -- see reference top left. Drive towards I-17 on Hwy 69 to Youngs Farm (now Mortimers) at jct with Cherry Rd (Hwy 169) at MP 281. This junction is 17 miles from downtown Prescott and 8 miles from Glassford Hill Road in Prescott Valley. Turn left (east) at traffic lights, drive 8.25 miles on Hwy 169 to trail head (N side of road, 1/4 mile past MP 8).  
 - Park here just before an "iron pipe arch" over a gate.  
 - Trail starts at this gate, going north along what was an old dirt road.

**Total out-and-back hike is 2.8 miles (easy)**  
 Trail is 4550 feet at start and 4680 feet at high point.
