



TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS

Distance: Prescott to TH is 7.5 miles, all blacktop.
 Drive NW out of Prescott on Iron Springs Rd (YC10) to jct with Granite Basin Rd (FR 374) at milepost 3.0.
 - This junction is 3.0 miles from Willow Creek Road (hospital intersection) or 1.6 miles past Williamson Valley Road.
 Turn right (north) at junction onto Granite Basin Road.
 - Drive 3.1 miles to Wekuvde picnic area on right and park there. This is the same TH as Spree trails 6 and 8.
This is a Fee Area (\$5). Free on Wednesdays.
 Take trail 350 to northeast. Do loop counter clockwise.
 - Start of trail 350 is on right, about 50 yards in from GB Road (NOT near toilets). It starts by first (leftmost) of 8 short wooden posts by carsonite sign.
 - Trail 350 immediately crosses a former road and heads towards a picnic table, then down to meet trail 351 after 0.1 mile (junction is across dry creek).
Total loop hike is 3.8 miles (moderate)
 TH elevation is 5640 feet, high point is 5930 feet
Description: Trail winds up and down through pines and past huge boulders, some with interesting shapes and markings of lichen. There are occasional balanced rocks.
