



**TRAIL SIGNAGE**  
 The single track trails are coded with colored arrows on the brown sign posts (carsonites) that define various circuits. On the map: BK=black, GN=green, PP=purple, PK=pink, RD=red and UN=unsigned. You may need to check both sides of the carsonites to see the colored arrows. Black is used to indicate the trail is part of various colored circuits. Note that pink meets itself at some junctions, as does green.

**TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS**  
**Distance:** Prescott to TH is 7.2 miles, all blacktop  
 From Courthouse Plaza, drive north for 5.5 miles via the hospital intersection to the traffic light on Willow Creek Rd at Commerce Drive. Turn left at this light onto Commerce and drive for 0.7 miles to the Brownlow TH parking on the left (you will pass one Stop sign on the way). The TH you want to hike from is in the NW corner of parking.  
**Total Loop hike is 5.1 miles (moderate-strenuous).**  
 TH elevation is 5280 feet (low point), high point is 5420'.  
**Description:** Pioneer Park has a very dense network of non- motorized trails, with some new single track trails constructed in 2017. This hike uses mainly single track, but expect to share the trails with mountain bikers and runners, and even an occasional equestrian. The trail environment varies from open meadows to tall chaparral (with juniper, pinyon pine & scrub oak standing higher, but no ponderosas). Many landmarks that can be seen from the trails -- use these early on to get oriented. From the high points there are some great panoramas.
