



HISTORICAL NOTE
 The cast iron pipeline along Banning Creek was used in the early 1900s to supply water to Prescott from Goldwater Lakes.

Old Schoolhouse Gulch Road (#67) motorized -- maybe dirt bikes or ATVs.

TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS
Distance: Prescott to TH is 2.8 miles, all blacktop.
 From Courthouse Square, drive south on US 89/Montezuma Street, which becomes White Spar Road. After 2.8 miles, turn left (east) into White Spar Campground (clearly signed).
 - This entrance road crosses Granite Creek, with a dirt parking area on your right before the campground – park here.
Total loop hike is 3.2 miles (easy to moderate).
 TH elevation is 5620 feet, high point is 5930 feet.
Description: Hike loop clockwise.
 To reach start of trail #396, go east out of parking area around gate onto motorized trail 67, old Schoolhouse Gulch Road.
 - Trail 396 starts about 50 yards along trail 67, on the left side of the old road, going east.
 This is a pretty trail, winding through the pines, with many ups and downs. Expect some mountain bikers.

PRESCOTT CIRCLE TRAIL
 Trail 396 is part of the Prescott Circle Trail. The Circle Trail is about 55 miles long and goes all around the City of Prescott. It was completed in mid-2015 (all but a two mile segment). For more info, purchase a copy of the *Guide to the Prescott Circle Trail* from the Highlands Center or from the Prescott Chamber of Commerce downtown.
