

TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS

Distance: Prescott to TH is 6.8 miles, incl. 1.6 miles dirt.
 From Courthouse Plaza, drive west out of Prescott on Gurley Street for 5.2 miles to a Y junction. On the way, Gurley St becomes Thumb Butte Road. Go past the Thumb Butte parking area (at 3.4 miles from Plaza). At the Y junction, go left on the dirt road signed Thumb Butte Loop Road. Continue along this road (FR 373) for another 1.6 miles to a T junction (this road is rough in places so go slowly). The T junction is by a large juniper, where FR 51 goes left. The TH for trail 333 is on the left opposite the juniper – park so you don't block any of the roads.


Total loop hike is 4.5 miles (moderate).

TH elevation and high point is 6400 feet, low point 6100 feet

Description: The Honeybucket trail (#333) was completed early in 2017, a reroute of a social trail. Hike the loop counter clockwise. It's a pretty trail with good views, that winds thru the pines, dropping down to a point just above Butte Creek. From that point, you hike north, climbing up on the Prescott Circle Trail then going west to #333. Many of the trails in this area were forest roads in the past (#322, #326, #327, #392).

PRESCOTT CIRCLE TRAIL

Trails #322 & #392 and parts of #327 are segments of the Prescott Circle Trail. The Circle Trail is about 55 miles long and goes all around the City of Prescott. It was completed in mid-2015 (all but a two mile segment). For more info, purchase a copy of the *Guide to the Circle Trail* from the Highlands Center or the Prescott Chamber of Commerce downtown.
