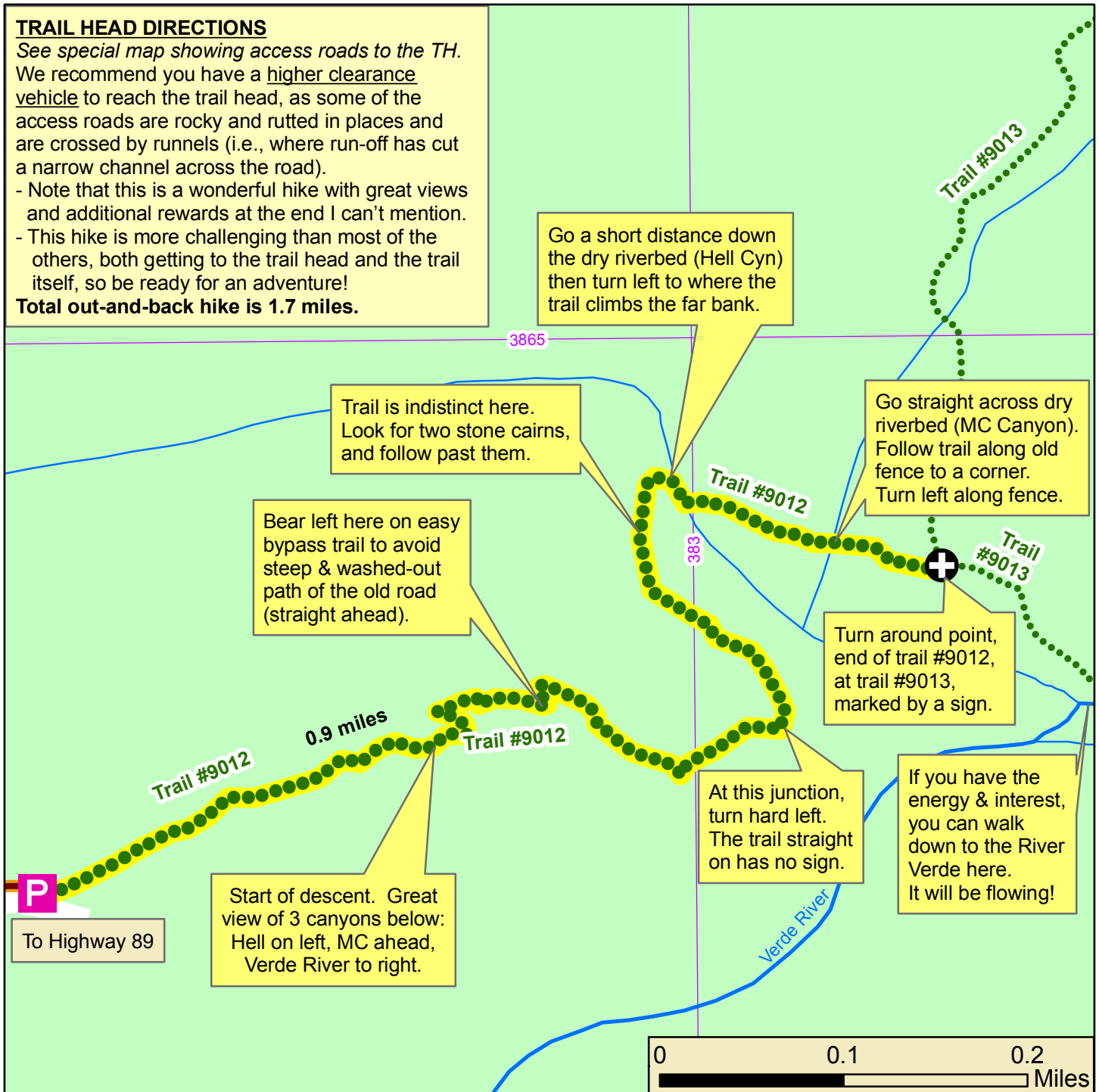


TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS

See special map showing access roads to the TH. We recommend you have a higher clearance vehicle to reach the trail head, as some of the access roads are rocky and rutted in places and are crossed by runnels (i.e., where run-off has cut a narrow channel across the road).

- Note that this is a wonderful hike with great views and additional rewards at the end I can't mention.
- This hike is more challenging than most of the others, both getting to the trail head and the trail itself, so be ready for an adventure!

Total out-and-back hike is 1.7 miles.
