**OPTION 2: ONE WAY HIKE**  
Park second car at Highlands Center. On hike, continue north past turn around point on trail #305 and go past both campgrounds to Trail #443. Then go west to Center (4.9 miles end to end). See Map 9, Stretch Pebble, for last 1/2 mile and parking info.

**OPTION 1: LONGER HIKE**  
Continue north on trail #305 as far as you like (winds through campground, 0.9 miles to next FR 623)

Turn around at FR 623 (blacktop)

Fence with V opening

Steep drop on right into scenic ravine

Mountain bikes use this trail too, more on weekends

Pretty up-and-down single track trail under tree canopy

Look SW across valley to see burn area on trail 297

**TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS**

Drive to Walker Road on Hwy 69 – this is east out of Prescott and west out of Prescott Valley.  
- Walker Road is at the traffic light by the ARCO gas stn (just west of Costco), at milepost 293.0. Turn south onto Walker Road (YC 57), and drive 5 miles to Bannie Mine Road, FR 30 (a dirt road).  
- This road is on left (east) side at milepost 5.0.  
- Turn onto this road and park on left (halfway up incline, on flat area by 'NO CAMPING' sign)  
The trail goes north from the parking area.  
**Total out-and-back hike is 5.2 miles (moderate)**  
Trail is single track and undulates a lot between 6050 feet at start and 5650 feet at low point.
